## Application Process

### 1. Carefully read the instructions below and select the preferred University/Hospital you'll like to have a placement in.

- Please note that each university may have more than one affiliated hospital and may decide to place you in any one of them.
- *If you have any question, please send us a message. We advise you to message us on Facebook for a faster response. If you are not on Facebook, then you can use email. We have tried to pack as much information about the Elective Placement into this document. Read through to make sure we have not already answered your question. Due to the number of students contacting us daily, we may only be able to answer questions that have not been addressed in this document.*
- We DO NOT encourage calls for 2 reasons:
  - **Legal Reasons:** *we don't want students telling us we did not give them information that we know we did, and vice versa. Chat history will easily solve this.*
  - **Follow Up:** *it's quite difficult to keep track of different student inquiries for follow-up when they call. So when next the student calls to continue the application process, it's difficult to remember what application stage that student was the last time he/she called. However, with messaging, we can easily read through the chat history and get updated on your specific inquiry when next you contact us. We would not need to start from the beginning.*

### 2. After decision, contact STUDENT TRAVELS UKRAINE ON Facebook to begin the application process.

### 3. Pay the **AGENCY FEE**.

Due to suggestions from our previous students, our Agency fee is now paid in 2 parts, (incase the student changes his/her mind or the elective is not offered). This is irrespective of the department or country you are applying to.

- **\$20 (before application)**
- **\$80 (only paid after elective placement is offered)**

Both fees covers;

- Consultation and Application assistance:
- Assisted form filling and documentation: We'll help you compile all the required document and submit to the university/hospital. *(Please see the general document requirements below)*
- Finding you a supervisor (when necessary)
- Planning your accommodation, flight and other travel logistics.
- Any other thing that may come up regarding your elective (except visa application)

- **\$50 (Only if you need visa application support)**  
If you are not an EU/EEA National and will need a visa to attend your elective, we can advise you on visa application FOR FREE. BUT, if you want us to do it for you, we can offer our **Full Visa Application Assistance** for an additional **\$50** Agency fee.
4. You will receive a response on your Elective Application in 2 – 3 months after application (...*the more reason you should apply early*)
  5. If you are offered a placement, you should accept the placement and pay the Administration/Tuition fees.
    - If you do not accept the placement within 1 week, it may be withdrawn.
    - If you decide to reschedule or cancel your elective dates, you must tell us as quickly as possible. (*N/b: Each university/hospital may have different rescheduling and cancellation policy. You may or may not be able to reschedule*).
  6. After you accept and Pay your administration fee, you will receive a **“Letter of Acceptance”**.
    - For UK Placements, you will receive a **“Certificate of Acceptance of Studies (CAS)”**. You will use this to apply for a **Tier 4 visa**.
  7. If you do not have where to stay, we will find you an accommodation for your elective period (in accordance with your budget).
    - University/Hospital accommodation may be less expensive but more difficult to get + Very few universities/hospitals offer accommodation to elective students, so we will find one for you.
  8. At about 3 months to the start of your elective period, you will apply for the appropriate visa.
    - **N/b:** *VISA support is NOT included in our Medical Elective service. Some students already have visas while some have EU/EEA passports. However, if you do not have a visa and you want us to assist you in obtaining a VISA, you need to apply for our VISA SUPPORT PACKAGE/SERVICE.*  
*Agency fee: \$50.*
  9. The University/Hospital will contact you again about 2 – 4 weeks to the start of your elective period to remind you of your dates and give you other information.
    - *Please do well to read the rules and regulations of the hospital you'll practice in. Each have different instructions, rules and regulations. This may include **dress codes and discipline in the hospital premises, timing, attendance etc.** It is important that you prepare accordingly and ask questions if you need clarification on any rule or regulation.*
  10. TRAVEL DAY: Congratulations, you are off to your elective.
    - **N/B:** Our services are still available to you for the entire period of your Medical Elective (already paid for in your Agency fee). Do not hesitate to contact us if you run into any issue or need some assistance.

## General Document Requirement

1. Application form *(We will take care of this)*
2. Application fee payment receipt *(you will get this after payment)*
3. Passport data page (scanned)
4. Passport photograph
5. Health Form (Immunization/serology Record/test) – *(we will tell you how to get this)*
6. Health Insurance (only required by some hospitals) – *(you should already have health insurance)*
7. Medical Indemnity Insurance – *(Not all hospitals need this, but if required, we will help get this)*
8. Police (criminal) Clearance Certificate from your current city – *(you can easily get this from your local police or immigration office)*
9. University Academic Transcript
10. English language proficiency Test Result (may or may not be required) – see section on **“Instructions & Information” (NO. 5)** below.
11. Dean’s letter of Approval (In most cases, the university/hospital will send you an Approval form your dean will fill, sign and stamp)
12. Curriculum Vitae (CV) and a personal statement *(Only required by some hospitals)*

*Please do not get discouraged by the thought of getting these documents. There are not difficult to get, and we will guild you all the way.*

## Eligibility, Instructions & Information

1. To apply for an Elective Placement, you MUST be in **CLINICAL YEAR**, which is defined as **4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> year students** (in a 6-year Medical course). There are some rare exceptions that may allow **3<sup>rd</sup> year medical students**. Please check the table below to see which.
2. If you need information on how to get any of the above listed required documents, please contact us and we'll guide you.
3. Your Medical University must be listed on the World Directory of Medical Schools: <http://search.wdoms.org/>
4. Accommodation is not included in your Administrative or Tuition fees unless otherwise stated. However, we can arrange accommodation for you at affordable prices. This price will be different from the Agency fee.
5. It is usually not possible for International elective students to purchase health insurance in the UK. You need to have one before you arrive. Moreover, your university supposed to have covered your health insurance, but if this is not the case, we will get a short term health insurance for you. They are quite cheap.
6. ALL PLACEMENTS STATED BELOW ARE IN ENGLISH.
  - This means your supervisor will teach you in English. It doesn't mean your patients will speak English, except you are having your elective in an English speaking country like the UK, Ireland, Australia, etc. for other European countries, patients will most like speak national languages, but your supervisor will be there to translate.
7. English Test may be required if you are applying to the UK (unless otherwise stated).

If English is not your first language (i.e. if you are not from a "**Majority English speaking country**"), you MUST provide proof of English language competence.

*(Majority English speaking countries includes: Antigua and Barbuda, Australia, The Bahamas, Barbados, Belize, Dominica, Grenada, Guyana, Ireland, Jamaica, New Zealand, St Kitts and Nevis, St Lucia, St Vincent and the Grenadines, Trinidad and Tobago, UK, and USA)*

### Acceptable English qualification includes:

- A. You must write either **IELTS or ISE II** if you want to apply for a Tier 4 visa, except you are from a **Majority English speaking country**.
  - **IELTS (Academic for UKVI)** – overall score of 7.0
  - **B2 Level ISE II - Trinity College London** – Integrated Skills in English: minimum – **PASS**
- B. If you are an EU/EEA National and will not apply for a Tier 4 visa, then you show any of the results below
  - **SQA** Standard Grade in English – minimum Grade 2
  - **IGCSE** English (First Language) – minimum Grade B
  - **Senior Secondary School Exam (SSCE)** with English as one of the subject – Grade B or better.
    - ✓ If you studied English Language in Secondary school and passed a Higher Secondary school exam with at least a Credit (Grade C), you MAY NOT need to take another English test.
  - **GCE A level** – minimum of B
  - **TOEFL** (*N/b: some universities do not accept TOEFL anymore*)
  - **International Baccalaureate**, English (higher or standard level) – Minimum of Grade 4

8. For UK Elective Placements, you MAY need to apply for a Tier 4 (General) student visa. In this case, a **Certificate of Acceptance of Studies (CAS)** Number is usually given by the university that will accept you. You can use this to apply for a UK Tier 4 Student visa.
  9. In the **PLACEMENT LIST**, if you see the phrase “**paid after acceptance**”, this means you will only have to pay an application fee AFTER your placement has been GUARANTEED. If you see the phrase “**paid before acceptance**”, this means you will have to pay an application fee BEFORE your placement is GUARANTEED. Placement it’s usually based on a **first-come-first-serve** basis, so apply early.
  10. In 90% of cases, GUARANTEE comes after a willing supervisor accepts your application. Usually, the university is responsible for finding a willing supervisor, but if that is the case, we will look for a supervisor on your behalf. However, we cannot guarantee that supervisor will be willing to accept you.

***Very Important: We will be processing applications for quite a number of students. Therefore we like to keep a history of discussion so we can follow up on you the next time you contact us. Because of this, we do NOT discuss by phone except it’s a general inquiry. If you’re making a specific inquiry for your placement, we prefer that you message us on Facebook so we can have a chat record and easily follow up on your next conversation rather than going over everything again.***
